Who We Are

We are the Lead Partner in the Tees Valley Music Education Hub and a Music Service working in schools and colleges across our four partner authorities of Stockton-on-Tees, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough and Redcar & Cleveland.

We provide instrumental and vocal tuition, workshops, school music curriculum delivery and support, consultancy teacher training including music technology and instrument hire. One of the 122 national Music Education Hub Lead Partners, ***we are first port of call for all music provision.***

Learning to Sing and Play

Grant-funded Whole Class Tuition is offered at every Key Stage to every primary school. Schools may also buy additional tuition so that their children can develop their skills further. This is often the very first experience a child has of hands-on music-making.

Small Group or Individual Tuition allows children to develop their skills to a more advanced level. Children are taught in school or at one of our ***Area Music Centres***. Pupils who have lessons with TVMS receive ***free membership to our ensembles and choirs.***

Music Centres and Ensembles

We have Music Centres in each local authority where ensembles, ranging from beginner to intermediate level, rehearse weekly. Players then advance to our Premier Ensembles, training the most advanced students at County-wide level.

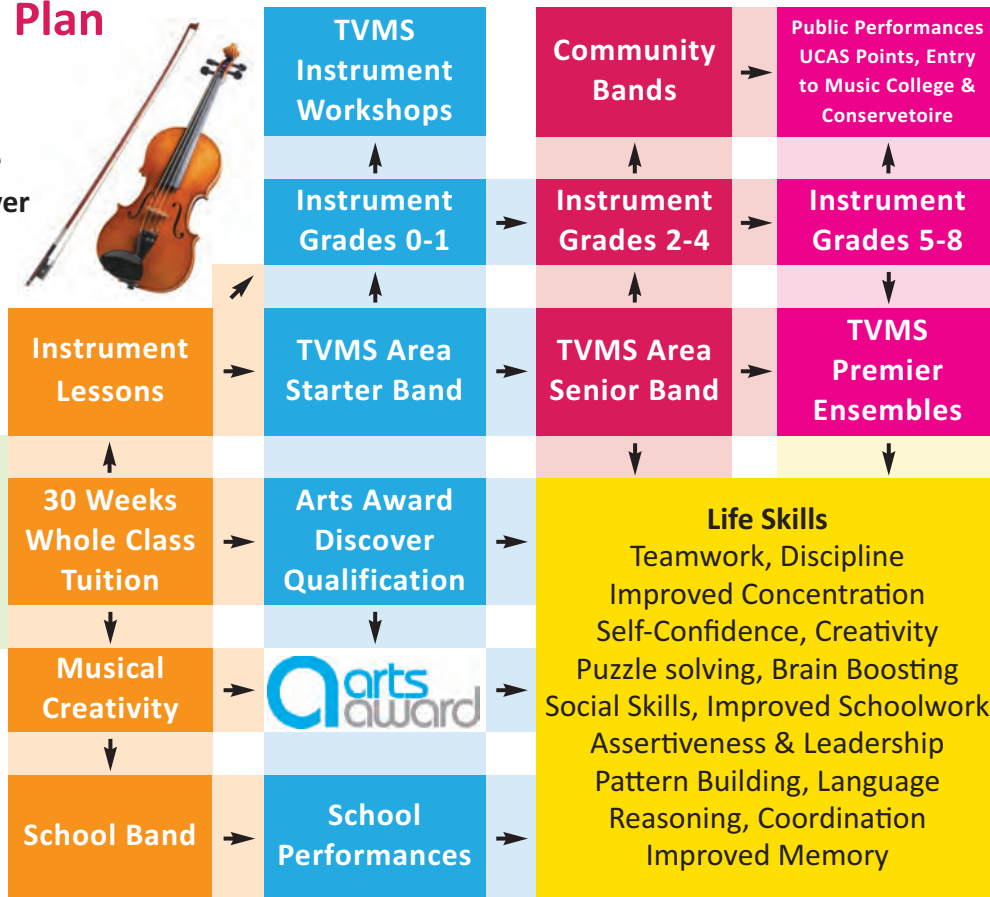



OFSTED 'DEEP DIVE' Consultation

Our consultation visit uses an audit tool that provides principals and teachers with opportunities to reflect on planning, learning strategies, interaction with lesson content, skills and student understanding.

OFSTED 'Deep Dives' into school music provision are now taking place nationally. Here are some examples of what OFSTED wanted to know from Senior Managers, Music Coordinators and children around the country (*thanks to Music Mark for sharing*).

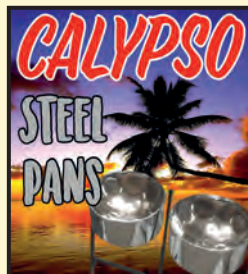
