Who We Are

TVMS is the lead partner in the Tees Valley Music Hub, a music service working in schools and colleges across our four partner authorities of Stockton-on-Tees, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough and Redcar & Cleveland.

We provide school music curriculum delivery and support, whole class and individual instrumental and vocal tuition, workshops, teacher training & consultancy. We are your first port of call for all school music provision.

Snappy Music

Snappy Music is the TVMS brand of curriculum delivery and CPD, workshops, school pop-up singing events, flashmobs and large scale big sing extravaganzas.

Our FREE big sings include KS2 Snappy Christmas, KS1 Snappy Spring and KS2 Snappy Summer, created in support of specialists and non-specialists delivering the music curriculum.

Music Centres & Ensembles

TVMS pupils receive free membership of our ensembles and choirs. We have weekly music centres in each local authority where beginner to intermediate ensembles rehearse. Players advance to our Premier Ensembles, training to a County-wide level, giving them a range of performing opportunities with players from other areas.

Learning to Sing & Play

Grant-subsidised Whole Class Tuition is offered at every key stage to every primary school. This is often the very first experience a child has of hands-on music making. Schools may also buy additional tuition to help develop pupils' skills further.

Small Group or Individual Instrumental Tuition is taught in school or at one of our Area Music Centres, allowing children to develop their skills to a more advanced level.

Serving the Community

TVMS is committed to providing events and workshops for the wider community, running community choirs such as Middlesbrough Community Choir and Yarm Wellness Choir to contribute to the positive mental health and wellbeing of the community.

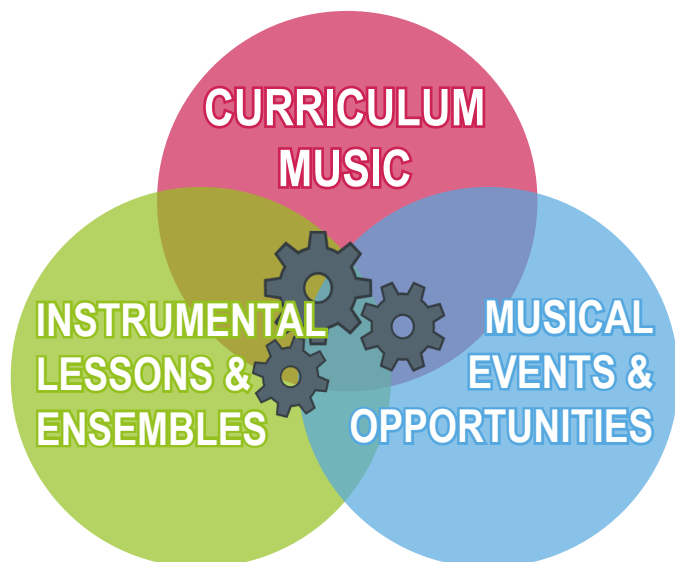

TVMS will help you develop and refine your school's delivery of the National Plan for Music Education and the Music Curriculum. This is a free review of your music planning, resources and provision to identify any support needed. This consultation takes about an hour and gains your school Music Mark status.

What is Arts Award, Music Mark & Artsmark?

ARTS AWARD is a nationally recognised pupil based learning programme (each gaining a certificate) with TVMS linking Arts Award Discover to its 10wk music programmes.

MUSIC MARK supports your school through CPD, training and resources. All schools signing up to an SMDA (see above) will be offered Music Mark membership and status.

ARTSMARK is a school award, recognising schools for their commitment to creativity. It takes about 2 years for a school to complete, and costs up to £500 for this award.

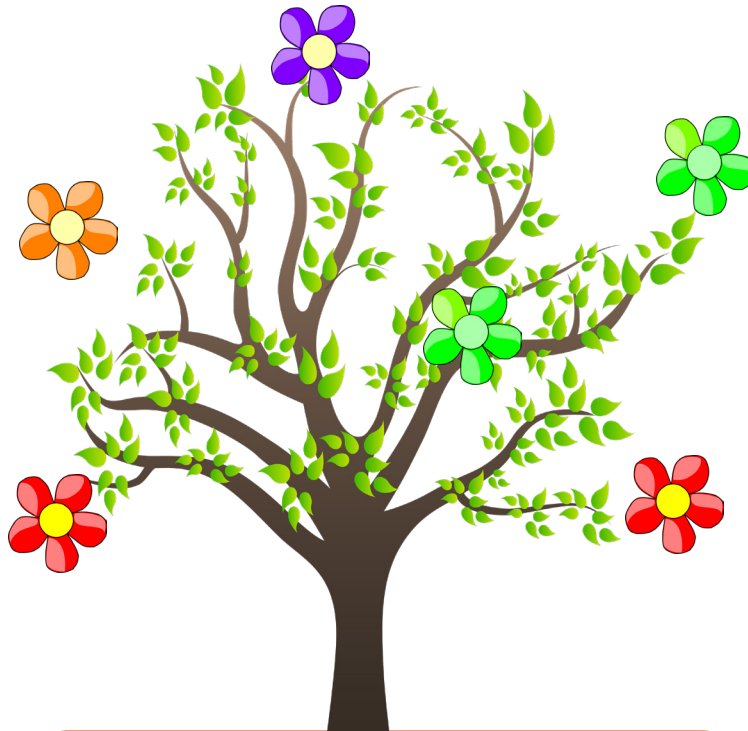

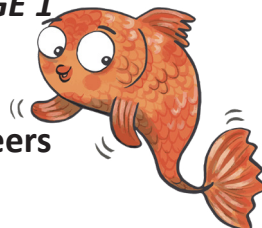

What is Snappy Classroom?

Snappy Classroom is curriculum based learning and uses the EYFS Statutory Framework.

Lessons are primarily singing based accompanied by school instruments. This allows teachers the opportunity to develop their music curriculum knowledge. Snappy Classroom can be 10-30 weeks and TVMS provides lesson planning documentation and a framework reward chart and certificates.
